Breakdown of fees

WEDDINGS & FUNERALS:

FOR ANY TYPE OF WEDDING OR FUNERAL SERVICE = £130 up to 3 songs. Each additional song £30 (for instance an aria at the reception, parts of the Requiem Gregorian plainchant, a song at the graveside, at the crematorium after the service) This includes admin. cost, guidance in choice of music and leading the hymn singing.

This price is for either unaccompanied solo singing, or with backing CDs only. Live Organ/Piano Accompaniment will cost extra (the venue may have an organist/pianist or I can arrange for an accompanist).

RECITALS and CORPORATE ENTERTAINMENT:

Each 40 min set costs £500, which includes my accompanist fees and all arrangements with the venue and equipment. I can arrange for an ensemble of singers (Psallite Singers) or instrumental ensemble (Orlando Trio) instead of a pianist, but each additional player will incur an extra cost.

OTHER CHARGES

TRAVEL EXPENSES - Petrol or cheapest available train ticket to the venue and/or taxis if necessary. (Advance Train Tickets are often half-price)

TRAVEL TIME - £10 per hour after **more than one hour** of travelling in each direction.

SINGING LESSONS:

I can travel to your chosen location anywhere within the Oyster travel zone of London. £50 per hour

Fees payable termly *in advance*. Any cancellations or changes in time/day need to be made 24 hours in advance
